Stringent guidelines are followed while selecting the manuscripts on the basis of its originality, relevance, importance and conclusions.

GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS

Preparation of Manuscripts: Manuscripts submitted to the journal must be original, and not submitted for publication anywhere else. All the matter and information should be submitted by email. Soft copy format should be in **MS word** only. Charts, Tables and Diagrams should be in MS Word and images in JPG format using maximum possible high resolution. All the matters should be typed in Times New Roman Font size - 11 point. Word with 1 - inch margin on all sides. Research papers (hard copies) should be prepared in duplicate and should be in 5 to 10 typed pages including illustrations and tables. All generic and species names should be printed in italic.

1. Format of Manuscripts: All manuscripts should be arranged as follows:-

- (a) **Title:** The title of paper should be concise, specific and informative, typed in capital letters.
- (b) **Authors:** Name of authors should be in capital letters.
- (c) **Address:** The name of the Institution where the work has been carried out and the address to which all correspondence concerning the manuscripts should be made. Add an E-mail address for easy and fast communication of all author & coauthors.
- (d) **Abstract:** An Abstract should be brief with salient points and important conclusions, not exceeding 350 words without references.
- (e) **Keywords:**
An abstract should be followed by not more than eight keywords indicating the contents of the manuscripts.
- (f) **Text:** Text should be divided into introduction, material and methods, observation/results, discussion, acknowledgements, and references. Mathematical symbols, Chemical symbols and Equation should be identified in text if required. Only standard international units should be used.

2. Introduction:

Introduction should be brief, specific and without heading. Avoid unnecessary details of earlier works.

3. Material and Methods: Material and Methods should contain relevant description and experimental techniques used. For well-known method, citation of the standard work is sufficient.

4. Results and Discussion: The result should include tables, graphs, charts and photographs if required and minimum number. Results should not be repeated in discussion.

5. **Tables:** Tables should be short and typed on separate sheets with proper heading and numbered in Arabic numerals and cited in text. Proper location in text should be indicated as T-1,2 etc.

6. **Figures:** All diagrams, graphs and photographs should be referred in the text as figures and numbered consecutively with Arabic numerals (1, 2 etc). All the figures should be provided with detailed caption and legends and should be typed on separate sheet. The original drawings should be made in black ink on good quality paper. Photographs should be clear, well contrasted and glossy prints. All inscriptions on the figures should be large enough to stand sufficient reduction. Photograph number and title of the article should be given on the back of each photographic plate.

7. **Acknowledgements:** It should be put at the end before references and should be selective and meaningful.

8. **References:** References typed in the following order:-

Use **American Psychological Association [APA] 7th edition** for citations and references.

After receipt of research paper It will be undergo assessment of the appropriateness of the topic for CEFJR, all manuscripts submitted to CEFJR will undergo pre-review by the editors or members of the Editorial Advisory Board before being sent to peer reviewers. The purpose of the pre-review process is to ensure that key features of the manuscript are sufficient—clear, transparent, and adequately reported—to facilitate a fair and informed evaluation by peer reviewers. Peer reviewers can do their job of assessing the quality of the work reported in manuscript only if they are given sufficient information. Thereafter, your paper will be sent to two reviewers and both reviewers should approve the paper. Their decision regarding acceptance will be final and binding. The editorial board reserves the right to condense or make changes in the research article.

10. When revision of a manuscript is requested, authors should return the revised version of their manuscript as soon as possible. Prompt action will ensure early publication if a paper is finally accepted for publication.

11. Authors will receive a pdf file with the edited version of their manuscript. The file will be password protected. Your login ID will be the password to access the PDF file. This will be the last opportunity to view an article before its publication in the journal. No changes or modifications

an be introduced once it is published.

12. Manuscripts accepted for publication will be published on-line as soon as they are ready for publication (that is when final proofreading is performed by authors, and all concerns are resolved). Once a manuscript appears on the Web site will be considered as published. However, print copy will also be published by the university.

13. After publication, the corresponding author is notified by email.

14. A properly completed Copyright Form must be provided for each accepted manuscript and that should be duly signed, scanned and sent via email to the Editor.

15. The Manuscripts will not be returned in any case whether accepted or rejected.

- (c) The submitted manuscripts should have a covering letter and undertaking with signature of the corresponding author.
- (d) A declaration certificate on the given format must be furnished by each author at the time of submission of manuscripts for publications.

5. Each Table and diagram/figure must be on separate page.
6. **Manuscripts must have-**

 - (b.) Names of author and all co-authors have full institutional and postal address with telephone numbers and email IDs.
 - (c.) Abstract and Keywords.
 - (d.) Text matter with Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion/Observation.
